



Step 1: Observation of values, missions and objectives

Step 2: Raise awareness of the process

What is a learning community in the Church? Experiences of UYT? Spiritual signifiance of UYT?

Step 3: Immediate value

Objectives: Create a sense of belonging

Activities: Interactions and listening to the innovations and the experiences of others. Set up collaborative meetings. Trade and capitalize (in a book? in a website? written records)

Step 4 : Potential value

Objectives: - Acquire potentially usable knowledge

Expand talents and the field of possibilities in relation to the existing

Activities: Create workshops, experimenting in places other than your own church.

Trade and capitalize.

Step 5 : Map talent

Objectives: - Know the assets existing in the Church and around the Church.

- Make the Church known as a assets for the personnal development.
- Create a feeling of belonging by getting to know each other better

Activities: Create assets map

Step 6: Realised value

Objectifs: - Carry out the community object

Activités : - Form project group and carry out activities

Step 7: Evaluate project performance

Evaluate project performance including the acquired talents. Trade and capitalize

Step 8: Redifine values values, missions and objectives

Objectifs: - Redefine values, missions and objectives

Activités: - Crystalize knowledge, hard skills and soft skills (individual and community). Trade and capitalize.


